## About us:

The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players, female or male. Please note that all participants must be at LEAST 50 years of age on the day of the tournament to compete.

## Dues \& Fees:

The MSC offers 10 Events per year, August through May. Entry Fees for each tournament are $\$ 90$ for Members and $\$ 100$ for NonMembers. The MSC Membership is $\$ 45$ per participant each season. Non-member fees are not applicable to the membership fee. Cash is the preferred method of entry fees.

For first time entrants, checks will be accepted.

## How it Works:

Payout is 1 for 2 , same day. The format is 7 random match games, with an $8^{\text {th }}$ game being a position round. The top 5 plus any seeds go into the stepladder. A 4 or 5 game Stepladder follows. When there are 4 or more Super Seniors or if there are 4 or More Real Old Guys, one must be in the ladder. There must be at least one bowler over 59 years of age in the ladder.

To cash, one must finish in the top $50 \%$ of one's age bracket, otherwise you DO NOT cash. Cashing will be based on 1 for 2 for each age bracket. Only exceptions: all players over 59 who finish in the natural prize list will cash.
Women are guaranteed a 1 for 2 pay out. .
The year-end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, a bowler must be a member and have played at least 3 tournaments in the 2021-2022 season.
Any questions regarding payout and scoring will be left to the discretion of the Director.

## Age Classifications:

50 through 59 is a "Regular"
60 through 67 is a "Super Senior" (SS)
68 and Older is a "Real Old Guy" (ROG).
One's age determines the bracket they are in.
Every tournament is certified by the USBC.

Sixty eight, 68, entries at McPete's!!! Astounding, not since 2008 has an MSC had at least 60 entries. The MSC is not used to this number. I thought the tournament moved along as well as could be expected. Our desk/data manager, Amy Oulman, did a wonderful job of collecting and posting the data quickly and accurately. Eric Peterson, our host, was apprehensive about us finishing in time for his 6:15 leagues. I, too, didn't think we could do it, but we did.

Thanks to all who showed and were ready to bowl when it was their turn.

John Hommes, unbeatable, as he won his 8 qualifying matches and won the all important last match, to win his $2^{\text {nd }}$ title. For the 9 games on a tough shot, he averaged almost 240. With this win, he moves to $3^{\text {rd }}$ in both the PoY and Prize lists. Hommes has had 9 2nds since his $1^{\text {st }}$ title. Five events remain, watch out for this guy.

Tim Baxter, bowling his $1^{\text {st }}$ MSC, acquitted himself well. He was $2^{\text {nd }}$ high qualifier, averaged 230 and won 7 matches. In the semifinal, he edged Clark Poelzer to advance. The title match saw Hommes throw almost nothing but strikes and Baxter couldn't get lined up. Nevertheless, a great event. Hopefully, he will bowl another MSC sometime in the future. I'm told he resides in lowa.

Finishing in $3^{\text {rd }}$ was Poelzer. He seems to always be in the ladder. He is looking for title \#22. He did defeat Jerry Holldorf and Dana Wright in the $1^{\text {st }} 2$ ladder games. Against Baxter, he was a strike shy of advancing. With this finish, he assumes $2^{\text {nd }}$ in the PoY and Prize lists.

Wright is seeking a $2^{\text {nd }}$ title. The match against Poelzer was close through 7 frames. A tough luck shot in the $8^{\text {th }}$ did him in. Wright was $2^{\text {nd }}$ high scratch in qualifying, won 6 games. He moves into $8^{\text {th }}$ on PoY list. With 5 events remaining, look for him to finish in the top 5.

Holldorf qualified $4^{\text {th }}$. He bowled well, averaging 220 and winning 6 games. He has a title to his credit. The match against Poelzer was close. He was a strike short of winning. Holldorf, a part time MSC player, had a very good event. Hopefully, we will see him more often.
