# MIDWEST SENIOR CLASSIC 

About us:
The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players, female or male. Please note that all participants must be at LEAST 50 years of age on the day of the tournament to compete.

## Dues \& Fees:

The MSC offers 12 Events per year, June through May. Entry Fees for each tournament are $\$ 90$ for Members and $\$ 100$ for NonMembers. The MSC Membership is $\$ 45$ per participant each season. Non-member fees are not applicable to the membership fee. Cash is the preferred method of entry fees.

For first time entrants, checks will be accepted.

## How it Works:

Payout is 1 for 2 , same day. The format is 7 random match games, with an $8^{\text {th }}$ game being a position round. The top 5 plus any seeds go into the stepladder. A 4 or 5 game Stepladder follows. When there are 4 or more Super Seniors or if there are 4 or More Real Old Guys, one must be in the ladder. There must be at least one bowler over 59 years of age in the ladder.

To cash, one must finish in the top $50 \%$ of one's age bracket, otherwise you DO NOT cash. Cashing will be based on 1 for 2 for each age bracket. Only exceptions: all players over 59 who finish in the natural prize list will cash.
Women are guaranteed a 1 for 2 pay out
The year-end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, a bowler must be a member and have played at least 4 tournaments in the 2017-2018 season.
Any questions regarding payout and scoring will be left to the discretion of the Director.

## Age Classifications:

50 through 59 is a "Regular"
60 through 67 is a "Super Senior" (SS)
68 and Older is a "Real Old Guy" (ROG).
One's age determines the bracket they are in.
Every tournament is certified by the USBC.

April's tournament will be hosted by Southway Bowl in St Cloud. This will be the first MSC event at this center.

The yearend event, to be held at Cedarvale, will be the money added event. Each cashing position will be enhanced by $\$ 100$. In addition, for the $1^{\text {st }}$ time, the MSC will have a post qualifying "SHOOT OUT", for all noncashers. The total prize for this will be $\$ 1000$.

Mermaid Entertainment center provided Rob Downer with another venue to add to his list of sites in which he has won. The pattern on which we played was "Stonehenge".

Downer averaged 246 in qualifying number 1. Racette emerged as his challenger in the title game. After 5 frames, Racette held the lead. Downer struck 7 of the his last 8 attempts to win. This title was his $4^{\text {th }}$ of the season and $16^{\text {th }}$ of his MSC career. He is on track to set a new PoY point record.

Tim Racette is looking to add to his 3 titles. Racette was 1 of 3 players to total 1900 or better. To get to the title match, he defeated Poelzer. After 5 frames in the title game, Racette had the lead. From the $6^{\text {th }}$ frame on, he failed to strike. He had a pretty good weekend, as he took over $2^{\text {nd }}$ in the St Paul city.

Third place went to Clark Poelzer. Poelzer is looking to add to the 18 titles he has accumulated. On a tough pair, he defeated Tim Peterson to advance to the semifinal. He shot a clean game against Racette, but had only 1 double to fall short of victory.

Tim Peterson had his best ever MSC, qualifying in $3^{\text {rd }}$, shooting 780 his last 3. Peterson had the misfortune of playing Poelzer on a tough pair. Between the 2 , they had 8 strikes, each had a double. Peterson had 2 splits which proved to be his downfall, as Poelzer played clean. As a result, Peterson finished a career high $4^{\text {th }}$.

Larry Hill, the RoG, finished in the top 5 for the second consecutive month. Hill qualified $7^{\text {th }}$ and was seeded into the ladder. He acquitted himself well, as he defeated Brian Floen in the $1^{\text {st }}$ ladder game. In this game, he had a double and was clean, good for a 203, which was enough to advance.
Floen was $5^{\text {th }}$ high qualifier. Floen is looking to add to his total titles of 11 . Floen had 2 opens in the opening ladder game versus Hill and lost.

A dubious record was set by Dave Oulman, as he shot 1965, an average of 246 and won only 2 games. This is the highest finish with the fewest wins.
