# MIDWEST SENIOR CLASSIC 

## Season 25, Issue 7

December 3, 2018

The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players, female or male. Please note that all participants must be at LEAST 50 years of age on the day of the tournament to compete.

## Dues \& Fees:

The MSC offers 12 Events per year, June through May. Entry Fees for each tournament are $\$ 90$ for Members and $\$ 100$ for NonMembers. The MSC Membership is $\$ 45$ per participant each season. Non-member fees are not applicable to the membership fee. Cash is the preferred method of entry fees.

For first time entrants, checks will be accepted.

## How it Works:

Payout is 1 for 2 , same day. The format is 7 random match games, with an $8^{\text {th }}$ game being a position round. The top 5 plus any seeds go into the stepladder. A 4 or 5 game Stepladder follows. When there are 4 or more Super Seniors or if there are 4 or More Real Old Guys, one must be in the ladder. There must be at least one bowler over 59 years of age in the ladder.

To cash, one must finish in the top $50 \%$ of one's age bracket, otherwise you DO NOT cash. Cashing will be based on 1 for 2 for each age bracket. Only exceptions: all players over 59 who finish in the natural prize list will cash.
Women are guaranteed a 1 for 2 pay out
The year-end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, a bowler must be a member and have played at least 4 tournaments in the 2018-2019 season.
Any questions regarding payout and scoring will be left to the discretion of the Director.

## Age Classifications:

50 through 59 is a "Regular"
60 through 67 is a "Super Senior" (SS) 68 and Older is a "Real Old Guy" (ROG). One's age determines the bracket they are in.

Every tournament is certified by the USBC.

Rob Downer was dominant in this event, as he averaged 244,14 pins more than anyone. He won all 8 match games and did not stop in the title match. With this win, he ties Clark Poelzer for the most career titles at 19. This was his $2^{\text {nd }}$ win of the season and moves him into $3^{\text {rd }}$ in the PoY list.

The title match had the same 2 finalists as last year's Drkula's event. Last year, Dana Wright defeated Downer for his $1^{\text {st }}$ title. Wright was the $2^{\text {nd }}$ high qualifier. To get to the final, he defeated Rick Henk in a close match that was decided in the $10^{\text {th }}$. Wright is looking for title \#2. Wright currently is in $2^{\text {nd }}$ on the PoY list as he is having a very good $1^{\text {st }}$ half season, with his lowest finish being an $8^{\text {th }}$ place finish.

Finishing in $3^{\text {rd }}$ was Henk, his high to date. His scratch total of 1847 was second high. He was $4^{\text {th }}$ high qualifier. He defeated 2 players to get to the semifinal. In a close match, he defeated Fred Schossow. He followed that with a win over Dave Oulman. As noted, he lost to Wright in a close match. A very good result for him. Should he play more MSCs, he would have better results.

Dave Oulman qualified $3^{\text {rd }}$. He has already won an event this season and is looking for title \#3. He is having a good season, as he is in the top 10 of the points list. In the game against Henk, he just could not get lined up, probably his worst game of the year. Doesn't seem likely that he would have another game like it this season. He will be a factor in all of the remaining events.

Finishing in $5^{\text {th }}$ place was the leader in the rookie of the point list, Schossow. He is off to a fine start, as this was his $2^{\text {nd }}$ top 5 finish. He defeated Mike Schmid in the $1^{\text {st }}$ ladder game and then lost to Henk in a close match. Look for him to win a title this season.

Mike Schmid was seeded into the ladder and lost the match in the $10^{\text {th }}$. Schmid has 3 titles and 19 other top 5 finishes in his MSC resume.
