# MIDWEST SENIOR CLASSIC

### About us:

The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players, female or male. Please note that all participants must be at LEAST 50 years of age on the day of the tournament to compete.

### Dues & Fees:

The MSC offers 10 Events per year, August through May. Entry Fees for each tournament are \$90 for Members and \$100 for Non-Members. The MSC Membership is \$45 per participant each season. Non-member fees are not applicable to the membership fee. Cash is the preferred method of entry fees.

For first time entrants, checks will be accepted.

### **How it Works:**

Payout is 1 for 2, same day. The format is 7 random match games, with an 8<sup>th</sup> game being a position round. The top 5 plus any seeds go into the stepladder. A 4 or 5 game Stepladder follows. When there are 4 or more Super Seniors or if there are 4 or More Real Old Guys, one must be in the ladder. There must be at least one bowler over 59 years of age in the ladder.

To cash, one must finish in the top 50% of one's age bracket, otherwise you **DO NOT** cash. Cashing will be based on 1 for 2 for each age bracket. Only exceptions: all players over 59 who finish in the natural prize list will cash. Women are guaranteed a 1 for 2 pay out. .

The year-end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, a bowler must be a member and have played at least 4 tournaments in the 2022-2023 season.

Any questions regarding payout and scoring will be left to the discretion of the Director.

### Age Classifications:

50 through 59 is a "Regular"
60 through 67 is a "Super Senior" (SS)
68 and Older is a "Real Old Guy"
(ROG).

One's age determines the bracket they are in.

Every tournament is certified by the USBC.

70 Entries! The last MSC with an entry number beginning with a 7 was in January 2004, 19 years ago, with 71 entries.

Fred Schossow, bowling at a high level the past couple of months, finally put it all together in winning his  $1^{\text{st}}$  Title. On his way to the title he defeated Todd Savoy and Dave Oulman. Schossow was high scratch qualifying leader, finishing  $2^{\text{nd}}$  in qualifying. He began the tourney with a couple of 250s. Anh he finished with a 260+ game for his win. Look for him to add more titles to his resume. With this win, he moves into  $2^{\text{nd}}$  in the PoY race.

Dave Oulman finished 2<sup>nd</sup> and was looking for his 3<sup>rd</sup> title of this season. He was the #1 seed. The title match saw Schossow throw the 1<sup>st</sup> 7 against Oulman. No defense against strikes! Oulman leads the PoY race, Has high average and has won the most prize money to date.

Third place was Todd Savoy, a part time MSC player and a USBC Hall of Fame member. Savoy qualified in 5<sup>th</sup>, defeated Clark Poelzer and Scott Cable in ladder games 1 and 2. He lost to Schossow in the semifinal. Were this guy to bowl more MSCs, he would have some MSC titles to go with all his other achievements.

Fourth was Scott Cable, bowling in his first MSC. This fine bowler showed that he has the skill to do well in MSCs. He qualified in 3<sup>rd</sup> and met Savoy in the 2<sup>nd</sup> ladder game. He bowled a great game but was one strike short of winning against Savoy. Hopefully he will bowl more in the future.

In 5<sup>th</sup> was Clark Polzer, second all time in career MSC titles.

In the 1<sup>st</sup> ladder game against Savoy, he just never got lined up, losing to Savoy. Poelzer is having a good year despite not having won a title as he is 3<sup>rd</sup> in the PoY race. There are 5 tournaments remaining in the season, so watch for this guy!

In 6<sup>th</sup> was John Hommes, missing the ladder by 18 pins. He is in 7<sup>th</sup> On the PoY race.
