# MIDWEST SENIOR CLASSIC

## About us:

The MSC is a bowling venue for fifty and older players, female or male. Please note that all participants must be at LEAST 50 years of age on the day of the tournament to compete.

## Dues \& Fees:

The MSC offers 12 Events per year, July through June. Entry Fees for each tournament are $\$ 90$ for Members and $\$ 100$ for Non-Members. The MSC Membership is $\$ 45$ per participant each season. Non-member fees are not applicable to the membership fee. Cash is the preferred method of entry fees.
For first time entrants, checks will be accepted.
How it Works:
Payout is same day ,approximately 1 for 2 (see below). The format is 7 random match games, with an $8^{\text {th }}$ game being a position round. The top 5 plus any seeds go into the stepladder. A 4 or 5 game Stepladder follows. When there are 4 or more Super Seniors or if there are 4 or More Real Old Guys, one must be in the ladder. There must be at least one bowler over 59 years of age in the ladder.

To cash, one must finish in the top $50 \%$ ( 1 for ) of one's age bracket, otherwise you DO NOT cash. Cashing will be based on 1 for 2 for each age bracket. Only exceptions: all players over 59 who finish in the natural prize list will cash.
Women are guaranteed a 1 for 2 pay out.

The year-end tournament has added money to each payout position. To qualify for the year end event, a bowler must be a member and have played at
least 4 tournaments in the 2022-2023 season.
Any questions regarding payout and scoring will be left to the discretion of the Director.

## Age Classifications:

50 through 59 is a "Regular"
60 through 67 is a "Super Senior" (SS) 68 and Older is a "Real Old Guy" (ROG).
One's age determines the bracket they are in.

Every tournament is certified by the USBC.

Another season is coming to a close. The 2022-23 season finale will be held at Flaherty's on June $25^{\text {th }}$. This tournament will have about $\$ 5300$ added to the prize list. A record 60 players are eligible to participate in the finale.

Also, as you know, Amy and I are retiring from running the MSC. The June year end will be our last event. For myself, a great experience and I want to thank Amy for the wonderful job she has done for the MSC.

A new director and data person have been chosen to assume running the MSC. They are Nick Hogan and Tony Fitzgerald.

As for the Southway tournament, Dave Oulman won for the third time this season. This victory cemented his claim as MSC PoY. Oulman averaged 245 , won 7 matches, had a 300 game in qualifying. He met and defeated Fred Schossow in the title game, 269 to 225.

Schossow was $2^{\text {nd }}$ high qualifier, averaging 230 and shooting a 300 in the semifinal ladder game against Brian Thelen to advance. Schossow was looking for his $2^{\text {nd }}$ title. As is known, no defense in bowling except matching your opponent strike for strike, which Schossow could not do.

Thelen qualified $3^{\text {rd }}$ and met Bill Faerber in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ ladder game. He bowled 223 to Faerber's 202, advancing to meet Schossow. Thelen is looking to add another title to his resume.

Faerber made another stepladder, still looking for title \#1. I think he will win one eventually. Faerber qualified $5^{\text {th }}$, shot a 300 the $2^{\text {nd }}$ game of qualifying. He averaged 226 for the 8 games. He defeated Clark Poelzer in the $1^{\text {st }}$ ladder game, 213 to 207 . The game was close, decided in the $10^{\text {th }}$ frame when Poelzer failed to strike, a good shot!

Poelzer was looking to add another title to his total of 22. Poelzer was $4^{\text {th }}$ high qualifier, was 1 of 4 players to shoot 8200 games in qualifying.

Missing the ladder by 25 pins, was Tom Jones. I believe this was his $2^{\text {nd }}$ or $3^{\text {rd }}$ such finish this season.
